GROWTH HEIGHT: 25 - 50 cm (DEPENDING ON VARIETY)

FLOWERING TIME: APRIL - OCTOBER

CHARACTER: A SUN WORSHIPPER, THE UBIQUITOUS

QUEEN OF BEDDING AND BALCONY PLANTS

CHARACTERISTICS: ABUNDANT FLOWERS, EASY TO CARE FOR, VERSATILE, AND FAIRLY DROUGHT-RESISTANT

ORIGIN: SOUTH AFRICA

AND GENEROUS WATER SUPPLY, NO WATERLOGGING
